Joan Maria Nin Génova was appointed as non-executive chairman of MoraBanc in April 2021 to provide a further boost to the bank's corporate governance with his extensive executive and governance experience in the banking sector and boards of directors in various sectors, especially energy (Naturgy, Repsol and Cepsa).

He began his extensive career as programme director at the Spanish Ministry of Relations with the European Economic Community (1978–1980). He was involved in negotiating Spain's accession to the Common Market. He has been managing director of Santander Central Hispano (1980–2002), CEO of Banc Sabadell (2002–2007), managing director of La Caixa (2007–2011) and vice-president and CEO of CaixaBank, Criteria and Fundació La Caixa (2011–2014), as well as a director of Société Générale de Banque. He is the current chairman of ITP AERO, as well as the European Advisory Board of the Dutch consultancy Metyis and Itínere Infraestructuras. He is now the chairman of the Círculo de Empresarios business association and the former chairman of Fundación Consejo España–Estados Unidos.

Born in Barcelona in 1953, Nin holds degrees in economics and law from the University of Deusto and a master's degree in law from the London School of Economics and Political Science. He has authored reference works, is a renowned analyst of the complexity of international relations, economics and politics, and is a leading expert in banking, business transformation processes and European politics.
